Red Bank area dentist commits time and energy to learn new advancements in bone and implant surgery.

Monmouth County implant dentist Bruce Bilow attends the Masters series oral surgery course in Miami Florida. This is the first of a series of advanced live surgery courses in the Masters series presented by Implant Seminars.

Implant Seminars was founded by Dr. Arun K. Garg. Since 1989 Dr. Garg has been teaching extensive hands-on surgical training workshops. With his textbooks on Dental Implant, Bone Harvesting and Grafting, Growth Factors for Dental Implants, being translated into eight different languages, Dr. Garg literally "wrote the book" on contemporary implant dentistry.

Dr. Garg and Implant Seminars provide quality continuing education on the subject of dental implants and related topics. At this lecture Dr. Arun Garg performed live surgeries on two patients . Dr. Garg was able to demonstrate the latest techniques in sinus grafting and an anterior ridge expansion with simultaneous implant placement. Both patients were only given a local anesthetic and were comfortable through out and after the procedure. Thousands of dentists across the country have been trained by Dr. Arun Garg and can attest to his clinical skill and mastery of the subject matter.

Many dental consumers want to know "What exactly is a dental implant ?" A dental implant is a tooth root replacement. After the dental implant is surgically placed where the old tooth root was, it will become one with your bone (this is called osseointegration) and a new crown can be attached to the implant. The new crown and implant will feel and look as good or better than your original tooth . When asked what is a dental implant Dr. Bilow often says "it is the best thing that has happened to dentistry."

Across the globe there is growing demand to replace missing teeth with dental implants. Patients are becoming more informed consumers thanks to educational efforts of dental teams and the availability of information on the internet. Patients are raving fans of dental implants and are spreading stories about how natural they feel, look and function. There is a bright future for dental implants.

Dr. Bruce Bilow states: "I have been restoring dental implants for more than twenty one years and was always amazed by the positive response patients have with dental implants. Now that I have started placing dental implants I am amazed at how quickly patients recover from the placement procedure and how much more control I have over the restorative phase of treatment."

Placement and restoration of dental implants takes a huge commitment of time and money to learn . Most of the top courses are out of state and have substantial tuition . Few dentists are able to leave their practices for the time it takes to become proficient at implant placement and restoration . Dr. Bilow states" I have taken over 200 hours of implant continuing education in the last year alone and will continue to take courses on implants as the information is constantly changing. "
